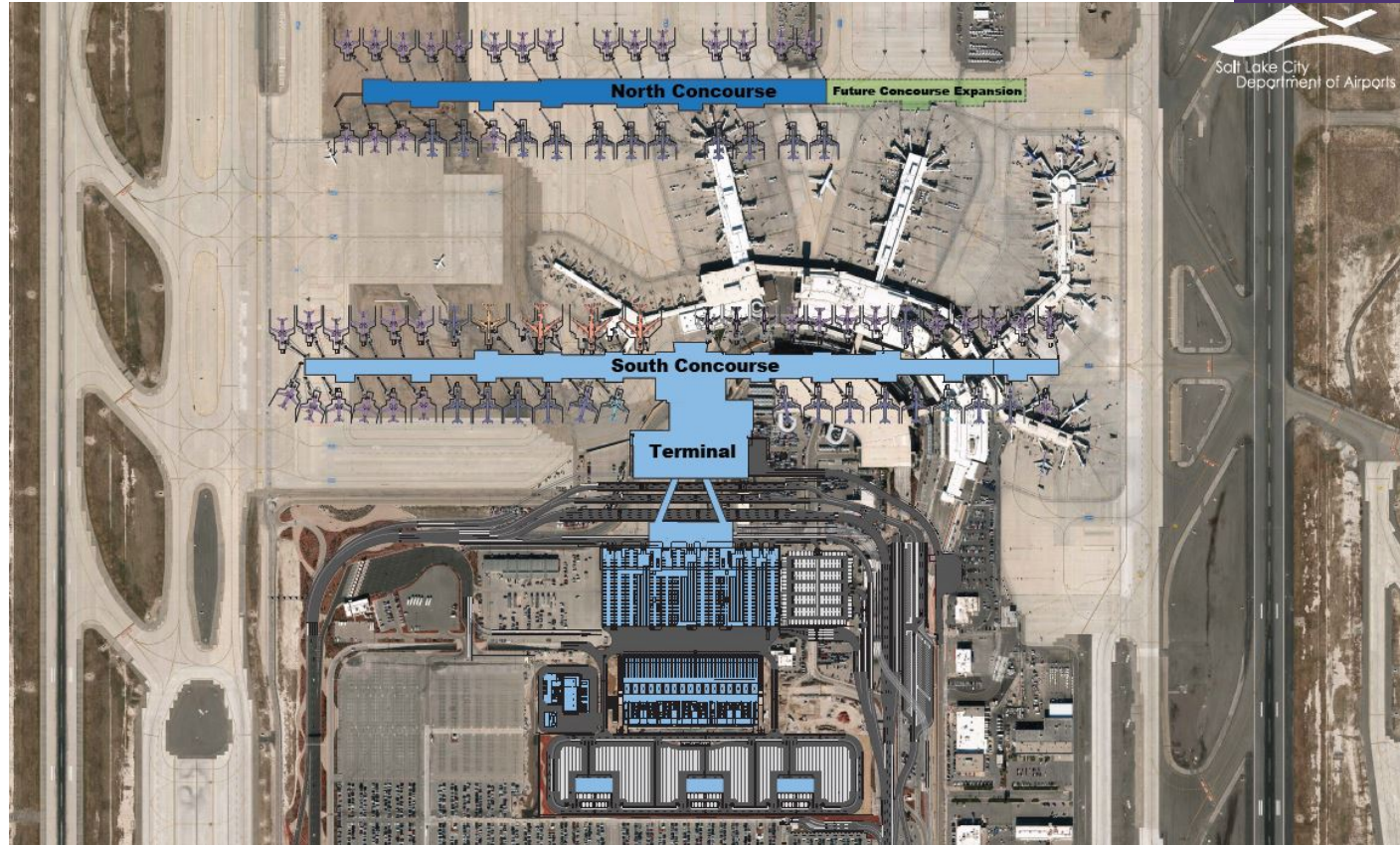

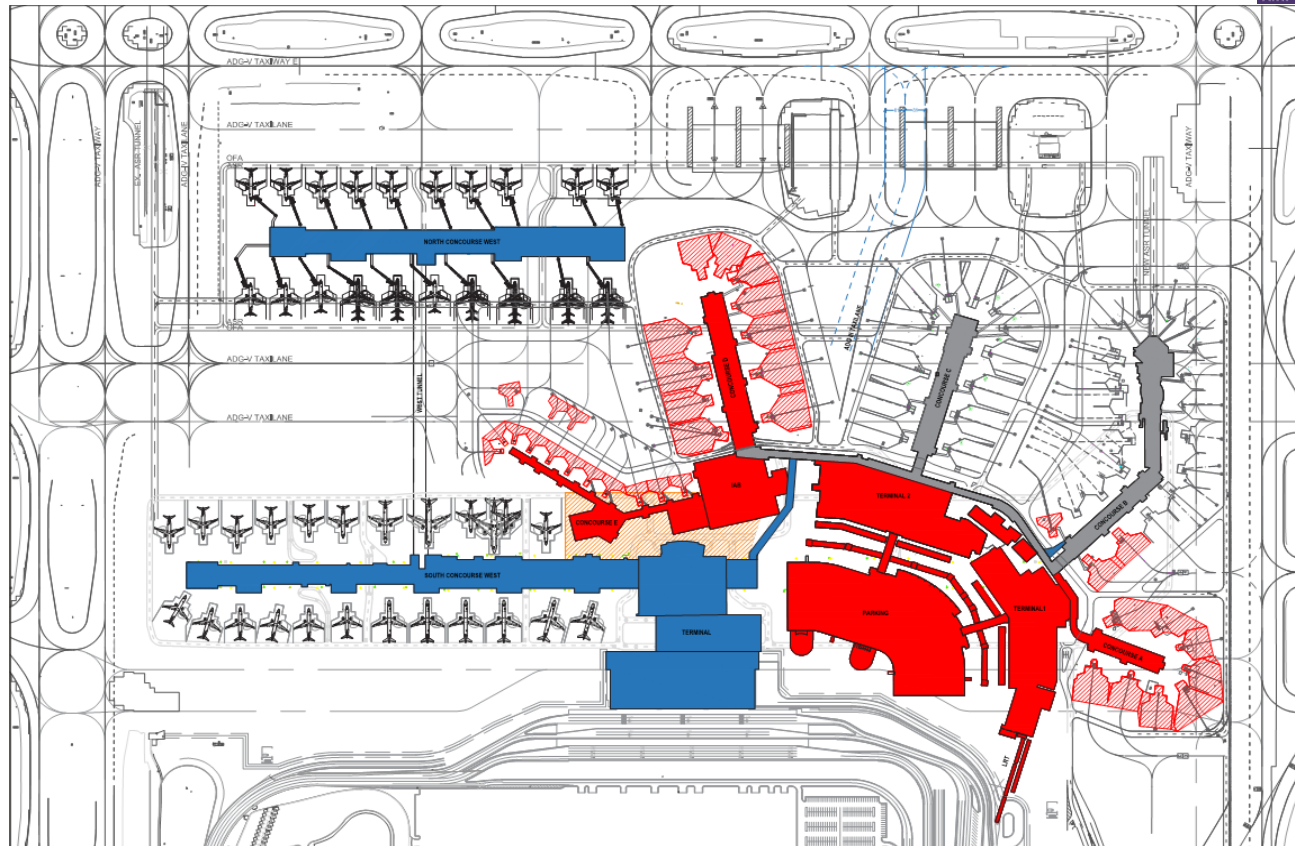
SLC Airport Redevelopment



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SLC Timeline

2014 - 2015

Announcement and ground breaking for The New SLC

Started construction of Rental Car Service Facilities and Quick Turn Around Facility

2016

Opened Rental Car Service Facilities and Quick Turn Around Facility

Started Terminal tunnel excavation

2017

Start construction on Central Utility Plant, Gateway Center, Parking Garage, Terminal, and the west side of the north and south concourses

Break ground on North Concourse-west

2018-2019

Continue construction on the Central Utility Plant, Gateway Center, Parking Garage, Terminal, and the North and South Concourses-west



Budgeting issues

- Roofing: \$1.2 million
- Restrooms: \$633K
Operational
- Restrooms: \$1.96 million +
- Carpet: \$970K
- People movers: \$0
