


Total International Traffic YE December 2010 - YE December 2017


Passenger Growth at Top 10 Airports YE December 2010 vs. YE December 2017

And now...biometrics

CBP Traveler Verification Service (From CBP:) WHY IT WORKS:

- Uses existing traveler biometrics
- No new data requirements
- Matches one to few utilizing cloud infrastructure
- Token-less processing
- Integrates into existing airport infrastructure
- Extends to land and sea environments
- Trusted source for identity verification
- 3,400 flights processed
- 485,000 participating passengers
- High 90 percentile of passengers have a photo available
- High 90 percentile match rate for passengers with photos







Impact of Biometrics

- → 11.8 minute reduction in wait time on entry
- → 350 passengers onto A380 at LAX in 20 minutes
- → So what does this mean for facility planning?
