- 120 were wounded, 20 were killed: 5 were US citizens



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
HOSTILE VEHICLE ATTACKS











THE THREAT ENVIRONMENT

Threat	Actor	Location	Description
Improvised Explosive Device	Any	Public areas	Simply constructed IED to attack public area of airport. (E.g. Brussels and Istanbul Airports)
Vehicle Borne Improvised Explosive Device	Any	Public areas	A vehicle-borne IED used to attack a public area of aerodrome. (E.g. Curbside ATB attacks, parking garages, etc.)
Firearm / Bladed Weapon	Any	Public areas	Active Shooter/Bladed Weapon attack in a public area of an aerodrome.
Hostile Vehicle	Any	Public Area	Use of a vehicle as a weapon on members of the public or infrastructure. (E.g. vehicle ramming – Barcelona, Nice, Berlin, London attacks)

Vehicle Curbs / Roadway Systems/ General Vehicle Access Areas	Public areas	- Check-in and bag drop areas - Passenger drop off areas - Pre-board screening areas - Pre-security screening retail areas Both terminals: - Arrivals, departures and service levels (T1 only) Inner curbs and outer curbs - Parking structures - Loading docks - HVAC bridge (from CUPP over the 409 adjacent to Viscount bridge)
