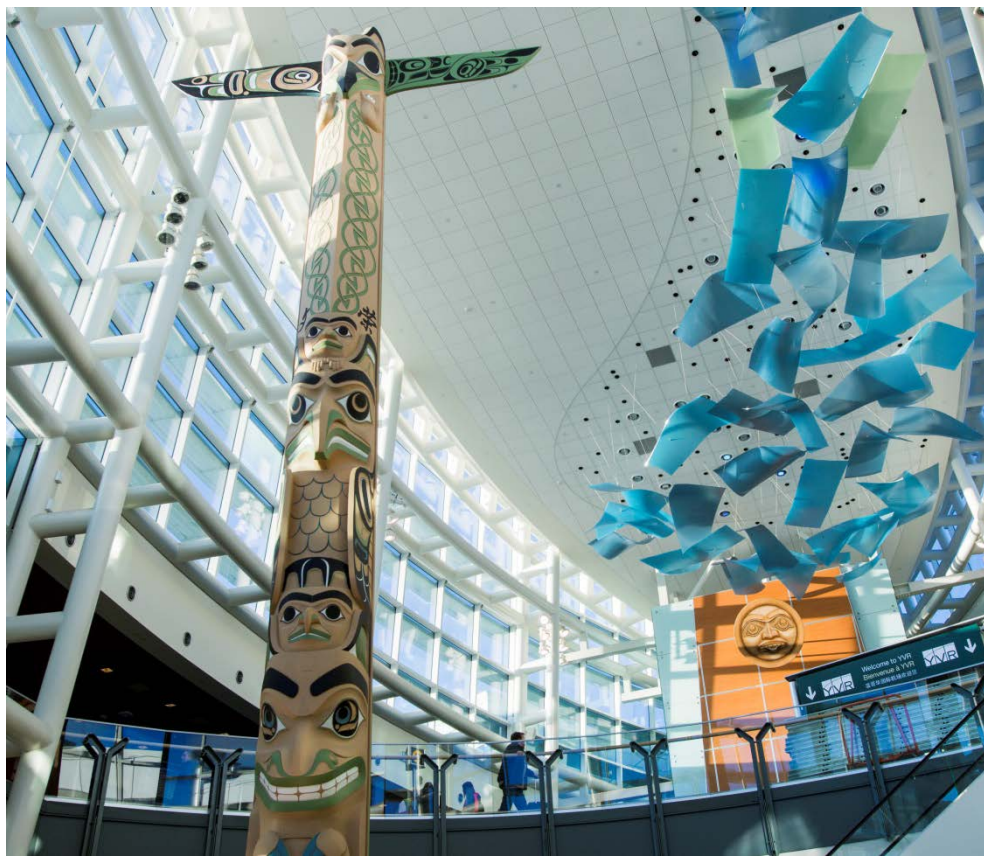

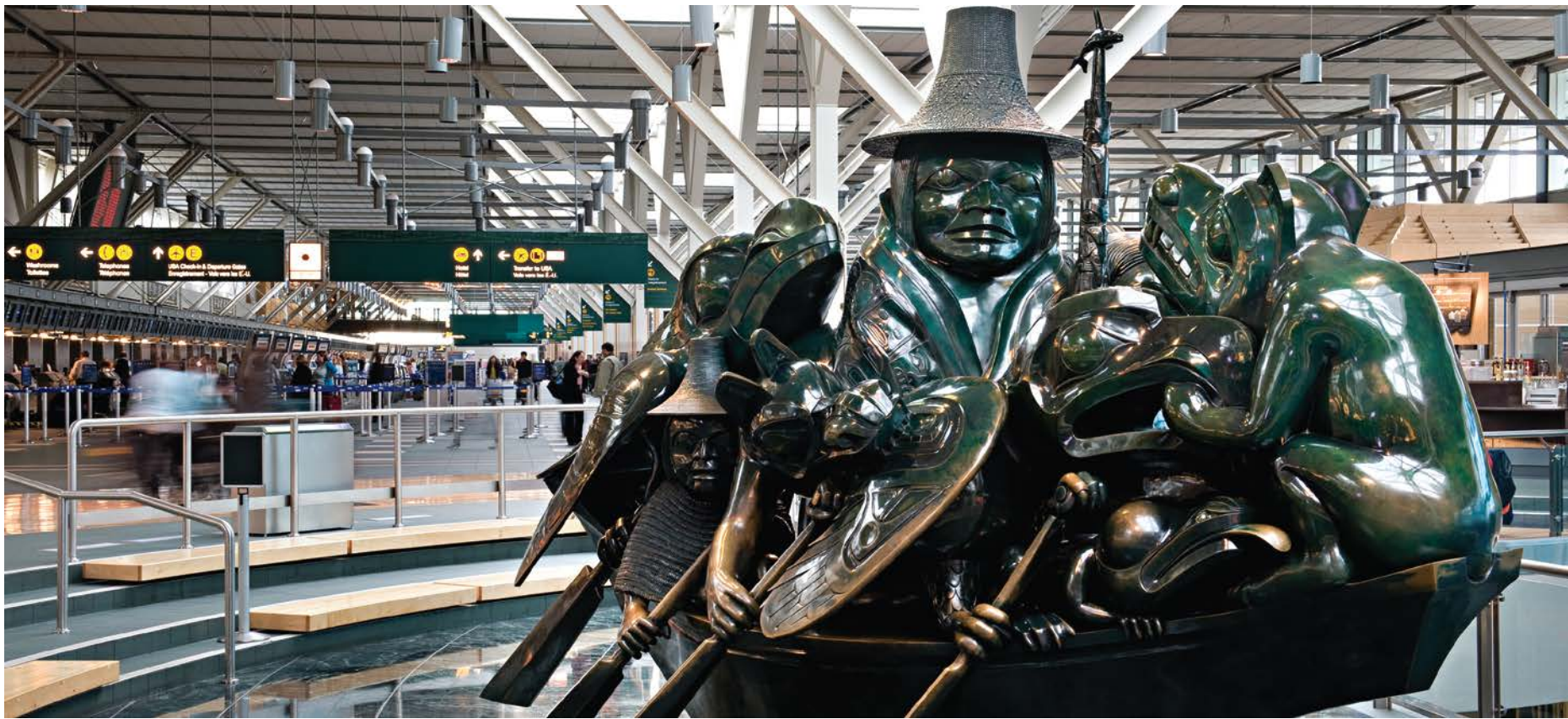






Vancouver International Airport (YVR) hosts the largest collection of northwest coast indigenous art on public display in the world





Art at YVR

- Both permanent and revolving collections
- Revolving Art Program draws on local BC artists to be showcased throughout the airport
- On-site full time curator at the airport together with several technicians



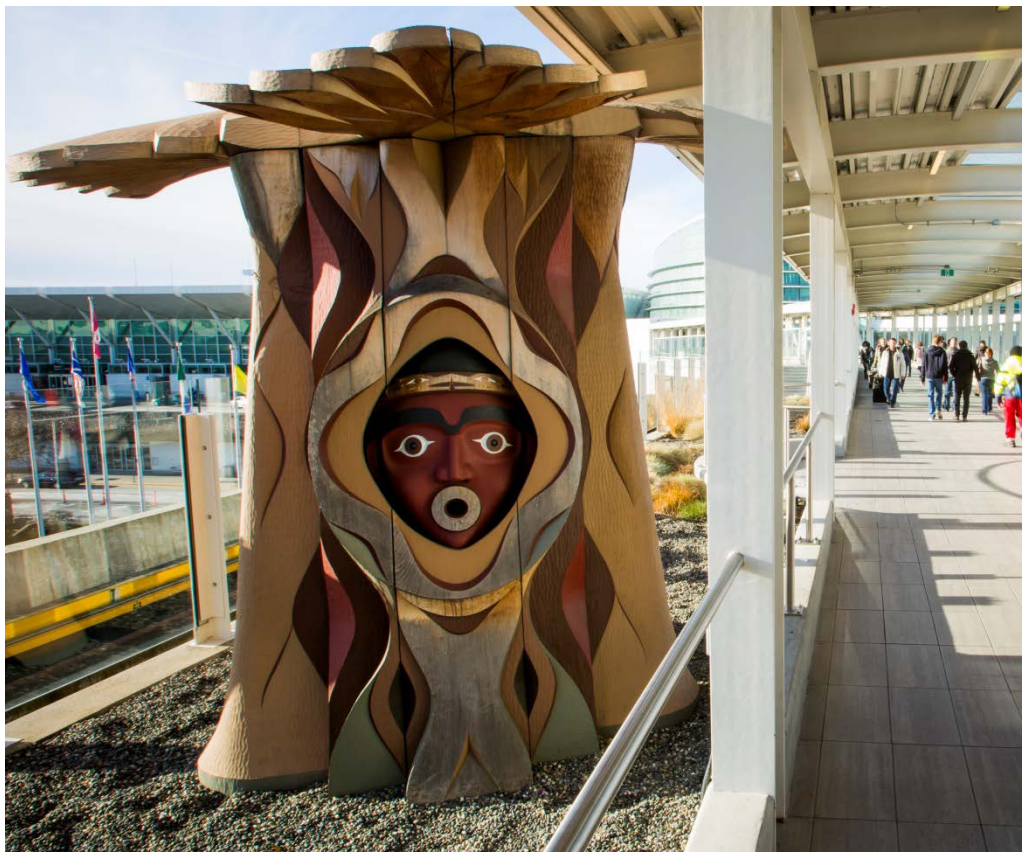


YVR Art Foundation

- Established in 1993 and dedicated to supporting the development and enhancement of BC & Yukon Indigenous artists
- Supporting emerging and mid-career artists with scholarships, grants, awards and exhibition opportunities
- To date, over \$400,000 and 100 scholarship, grants and awards to these artists







Procurement of Permanent Art Collections

- conducted through a competitive RFP process
- one of the key features is to ensure that the art piece/sculpture fits within the sense of place









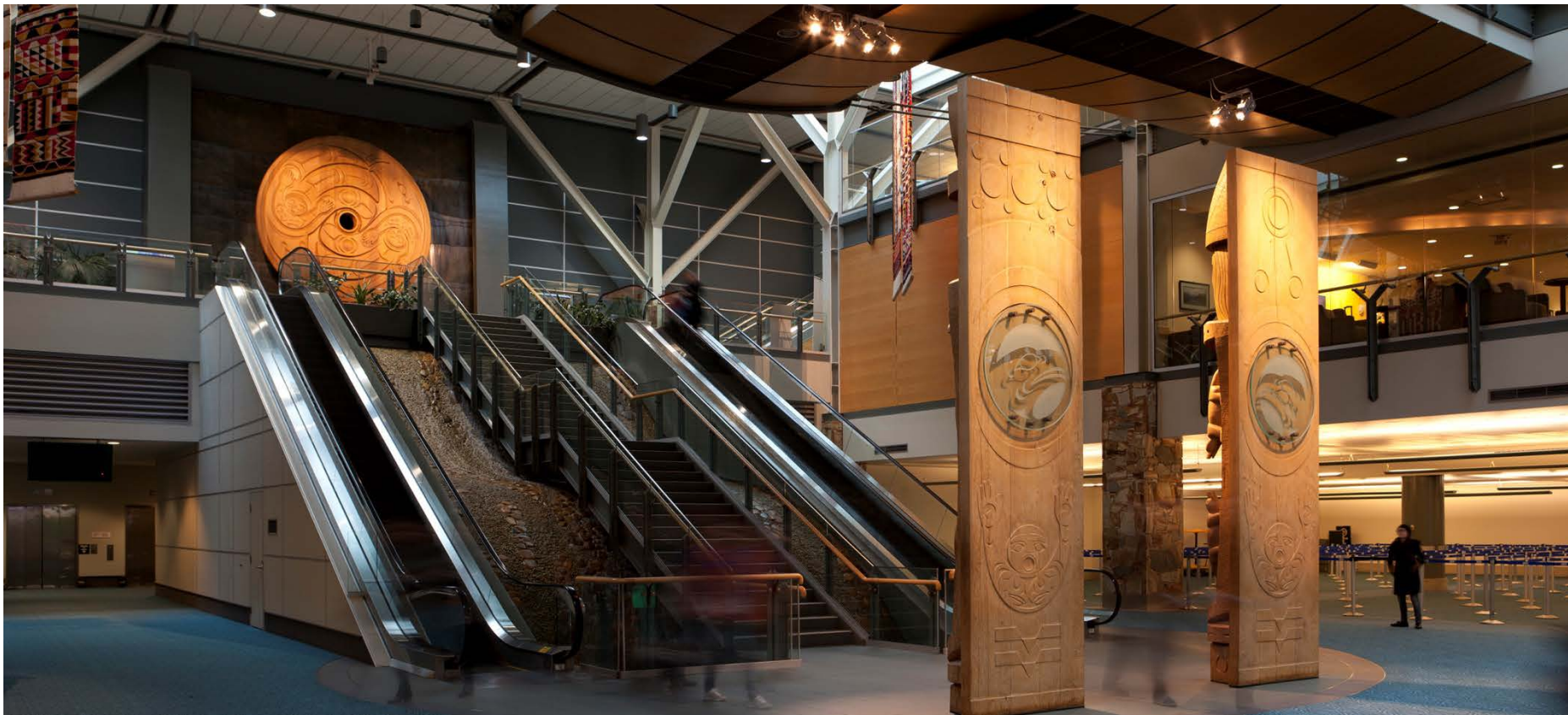




Legal Issues
