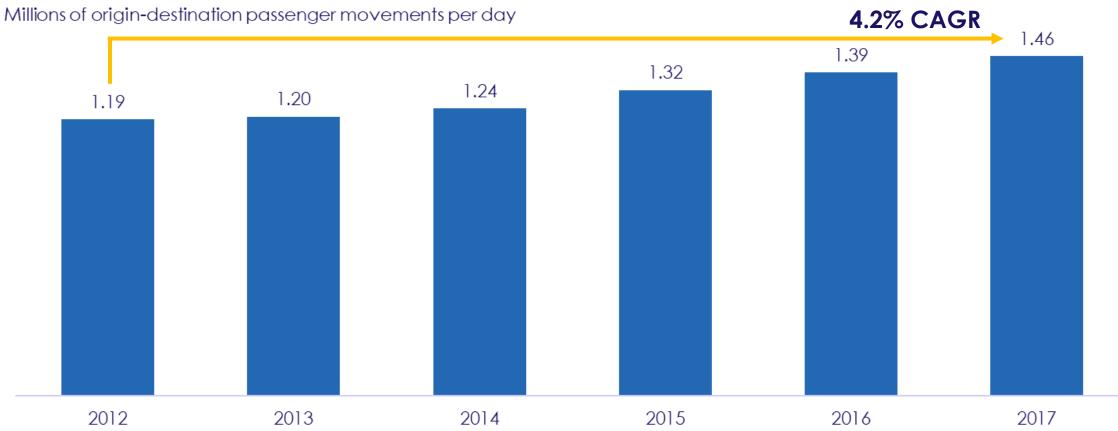

Percent compound annual growth rate (CAGR)



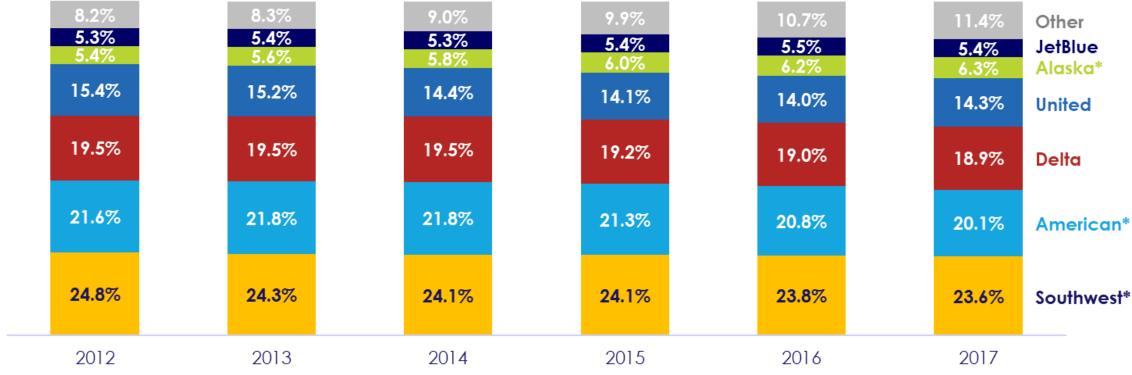

2012-2017 CARRIER SHARE OF DOMESTIC ORIGIN-DESTINATION DEMAND

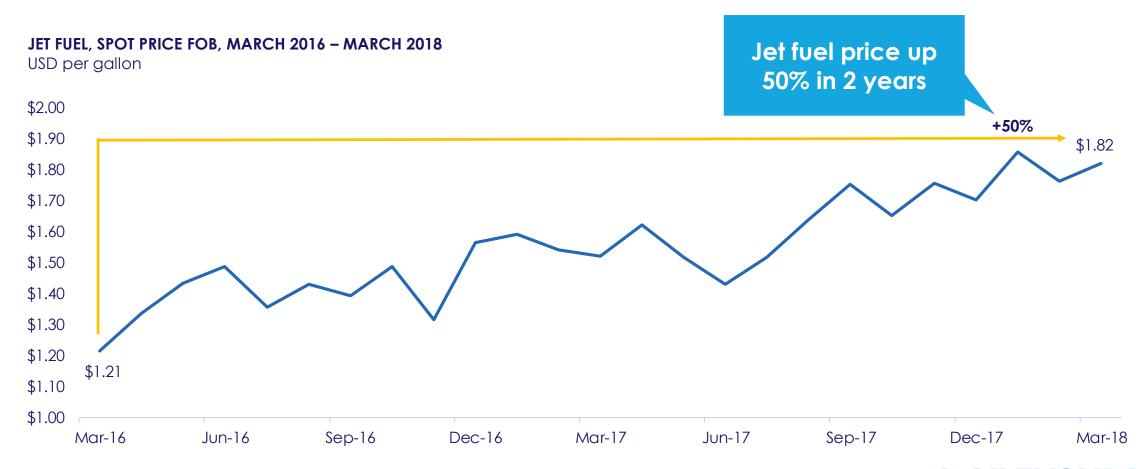
Percent of total domestic origin-destination demand

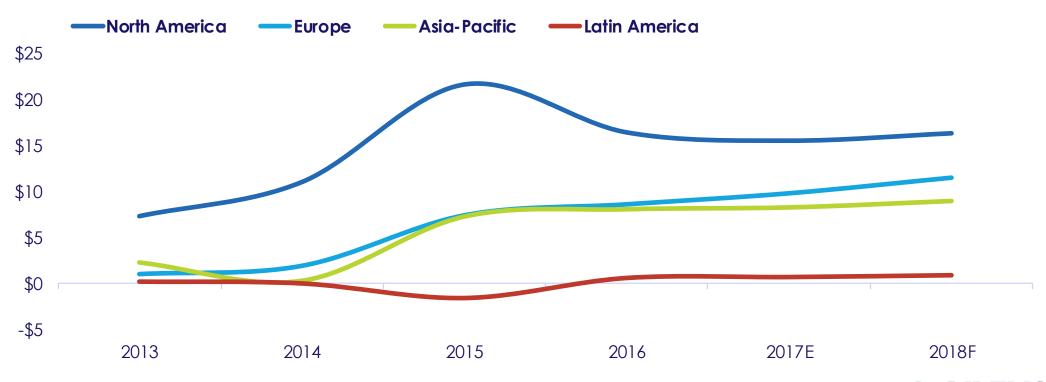

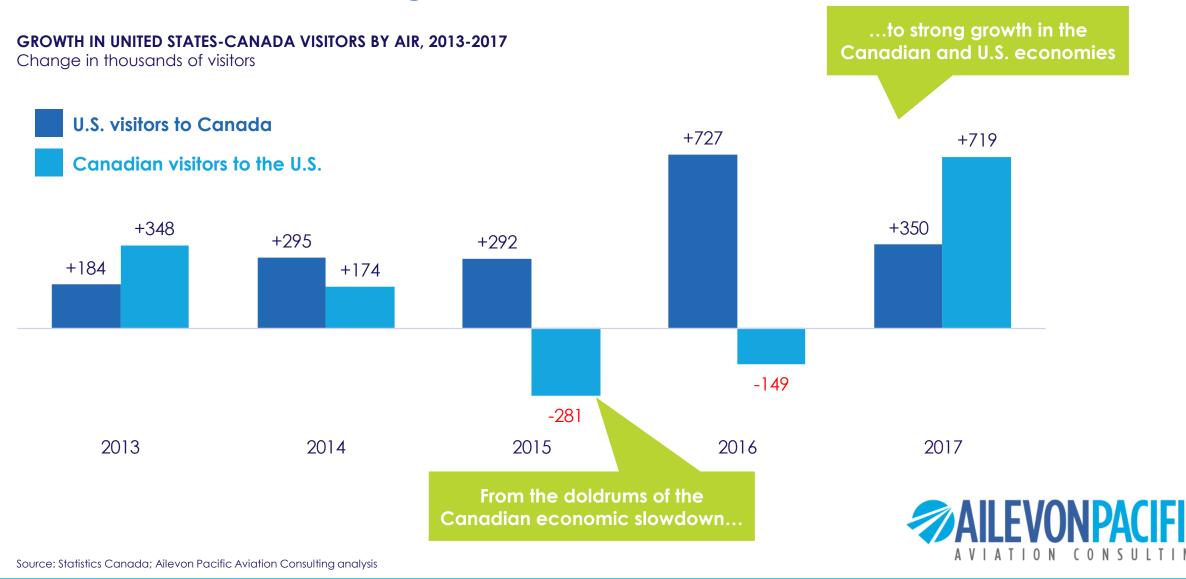






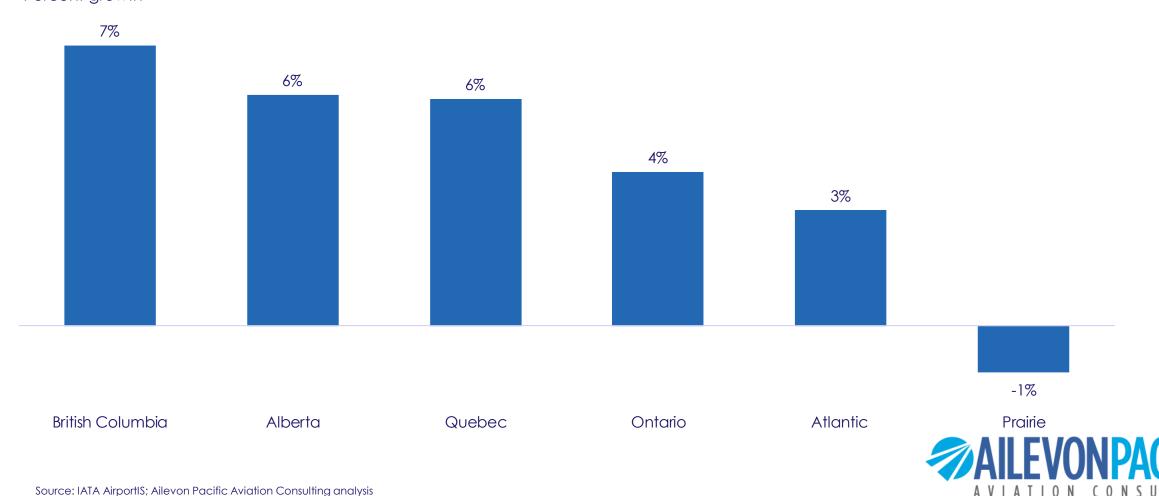

Canada: A rebounding Trans-Border market



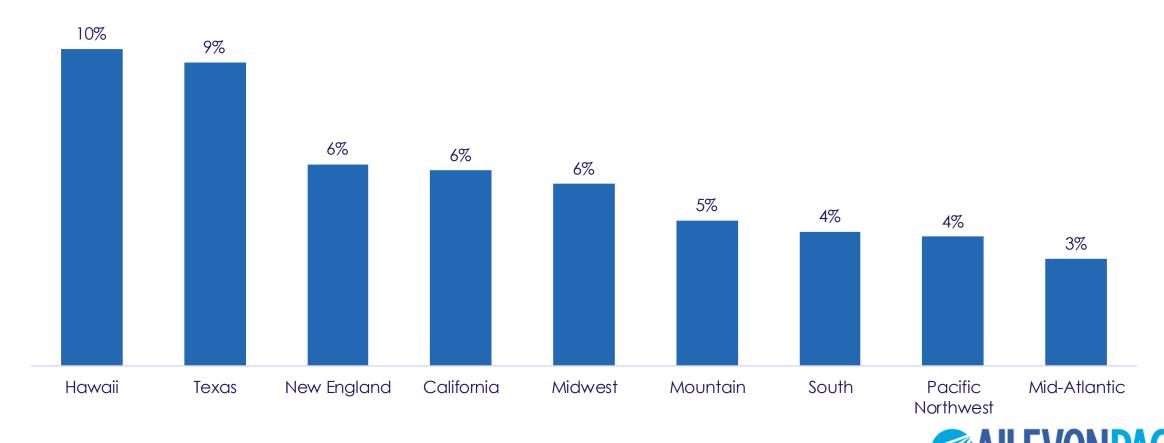
Almost all Canadian regions show positive growth

Similarly the U.S. is growing rapidly, led by Hawaii & Texas

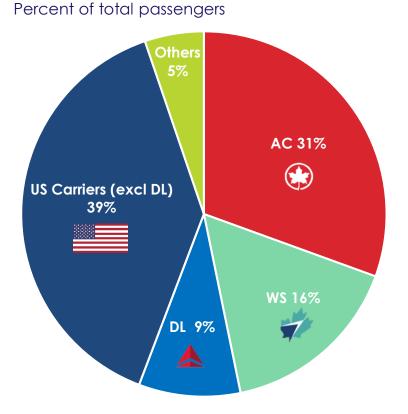

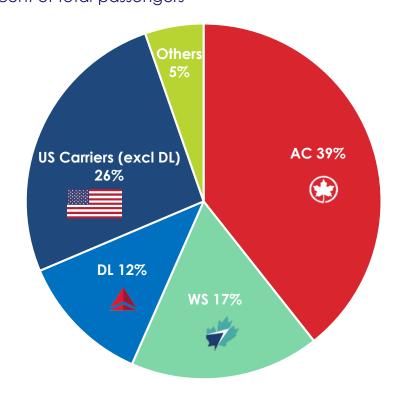

CARRIER SHARE OF U.S.-CANADA O&D DEMAND, 2017 Percent of total passengers



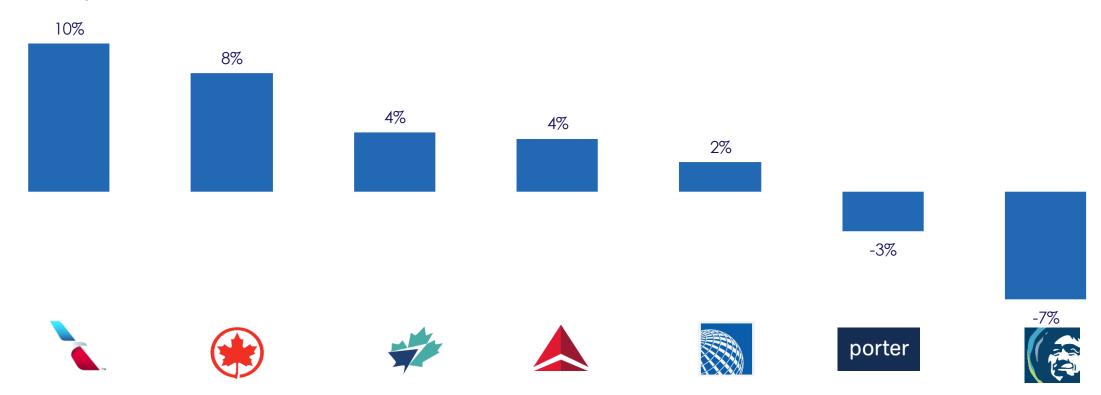

Percent growth in seat capacity









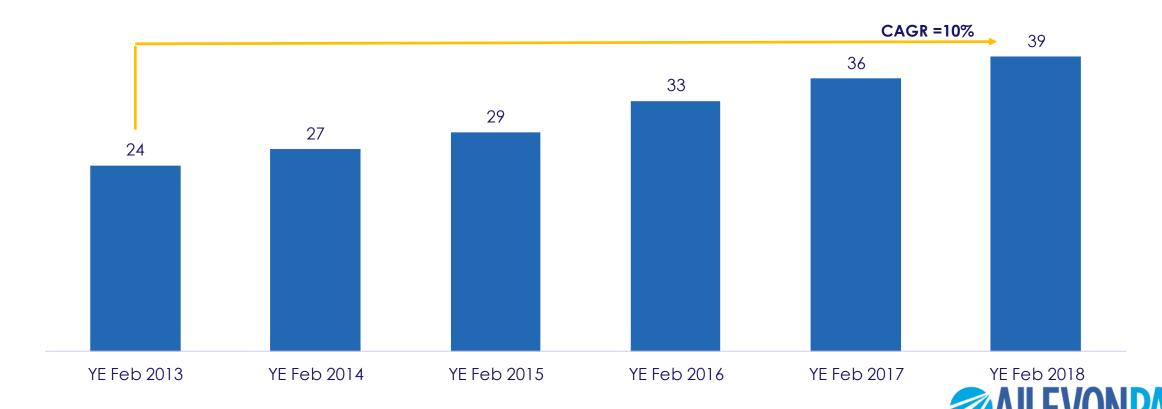

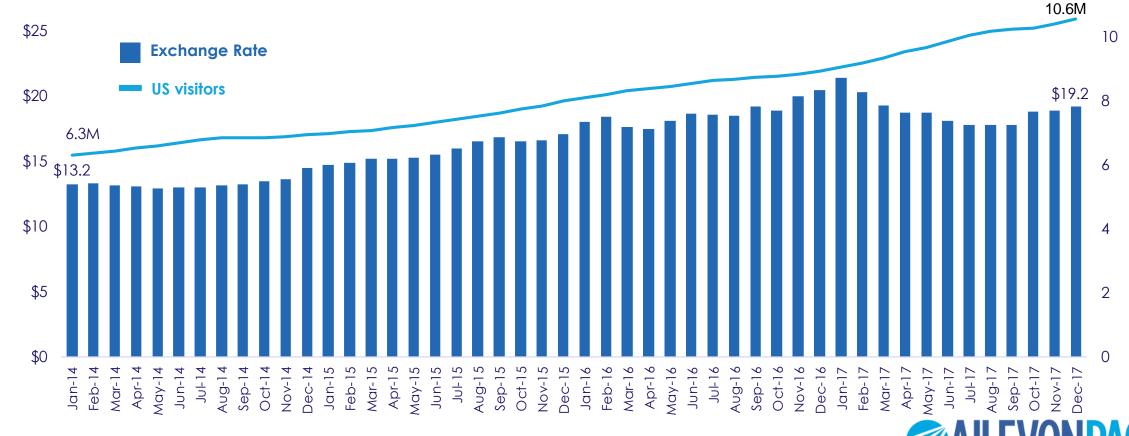

\$1 USD equivalent of Mexican Peso (column), Millions of US visitors (line)

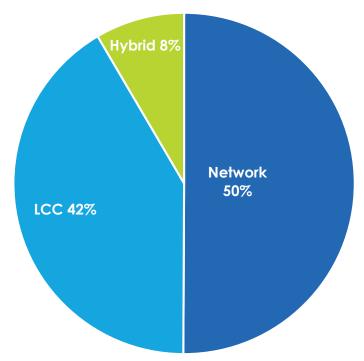

Percent of total seats



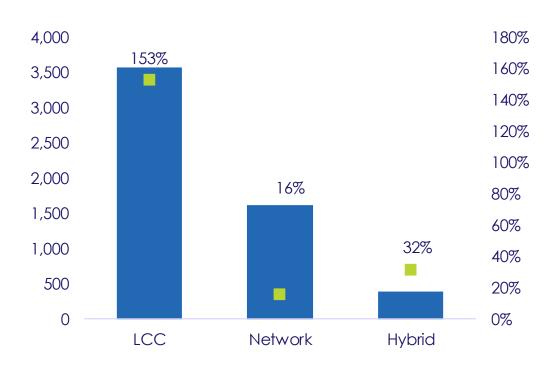

Growth in thousands of one-way seats(column), percent growth (scatter)

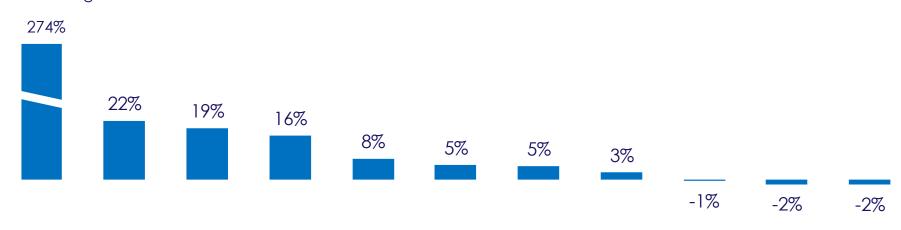

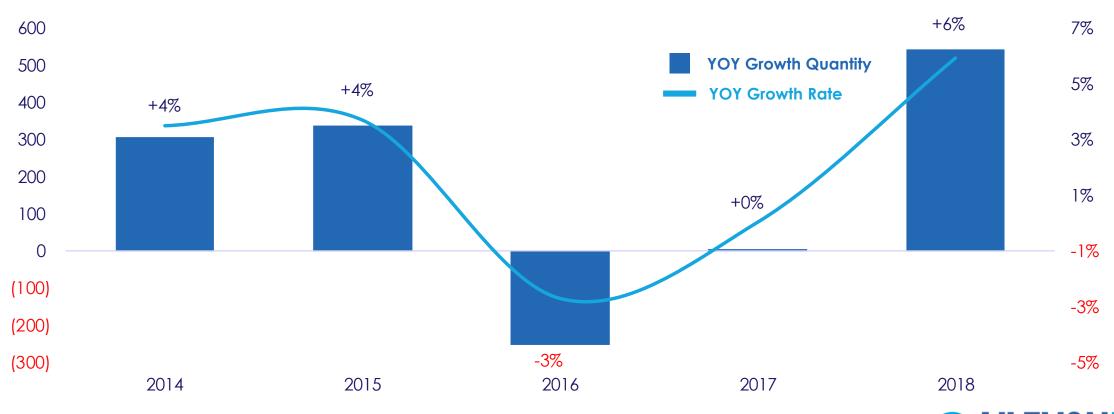

Brazil – South America's largest economy – is driving the turnaround as its economy rebounds

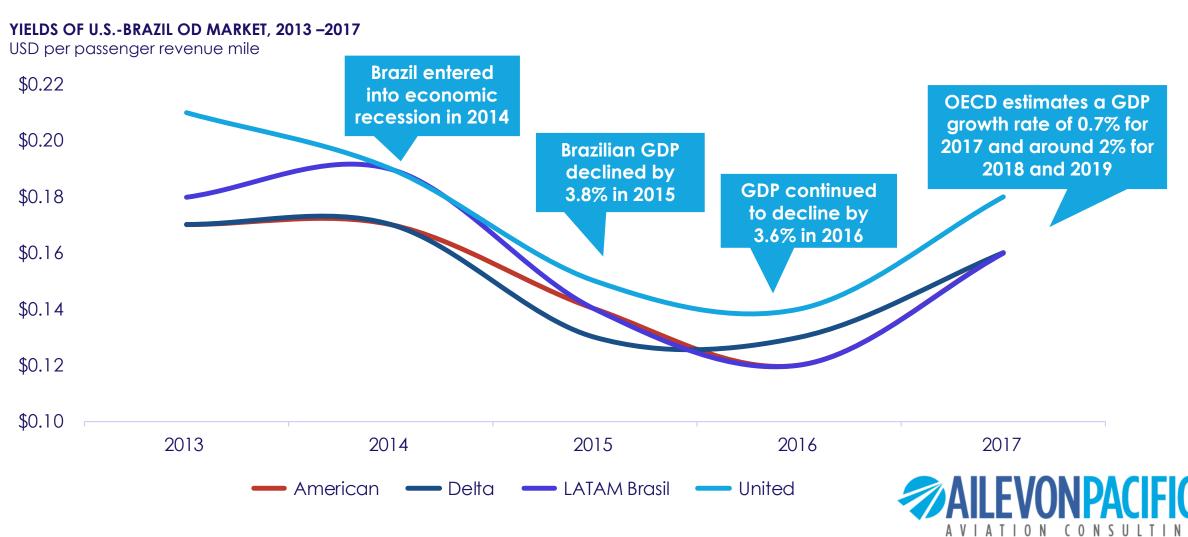
UNITED STATES-BRAZIL SEAT CAPACITY GROWTH IN QUANTITY AND PERCENTAGE, 2014-2018

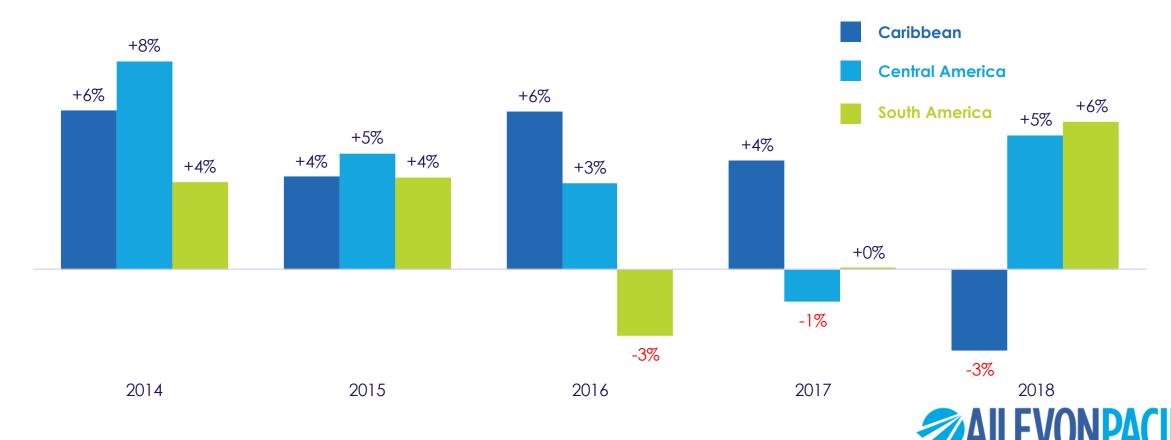

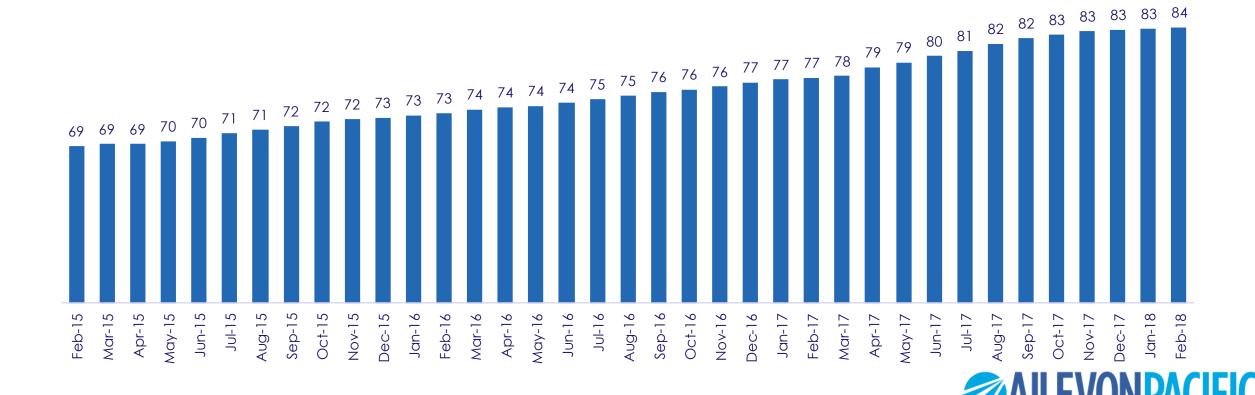


Trans-Atlantic

Thousands of passengers per day each way, rolling 12 months

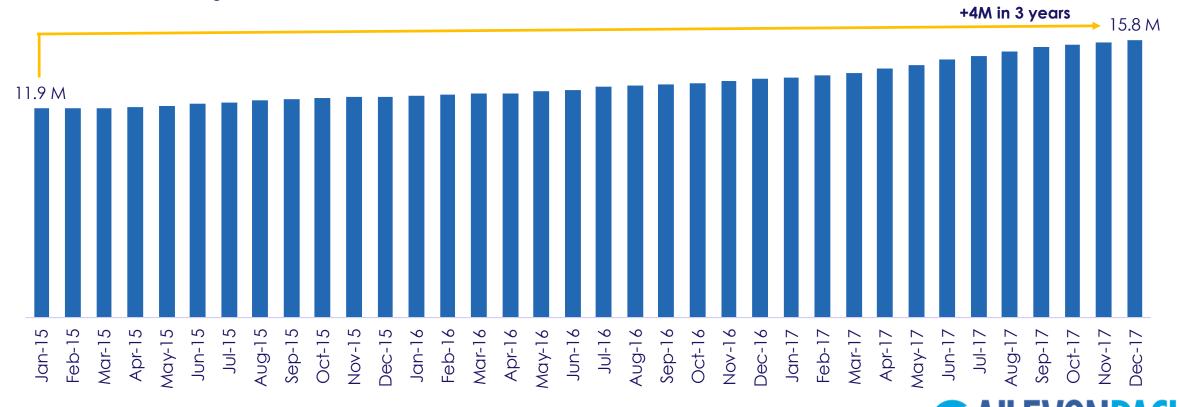




This growth is driven by strong growth in US outbound demand to Europe

Millions of US visitors, rolling 12 months

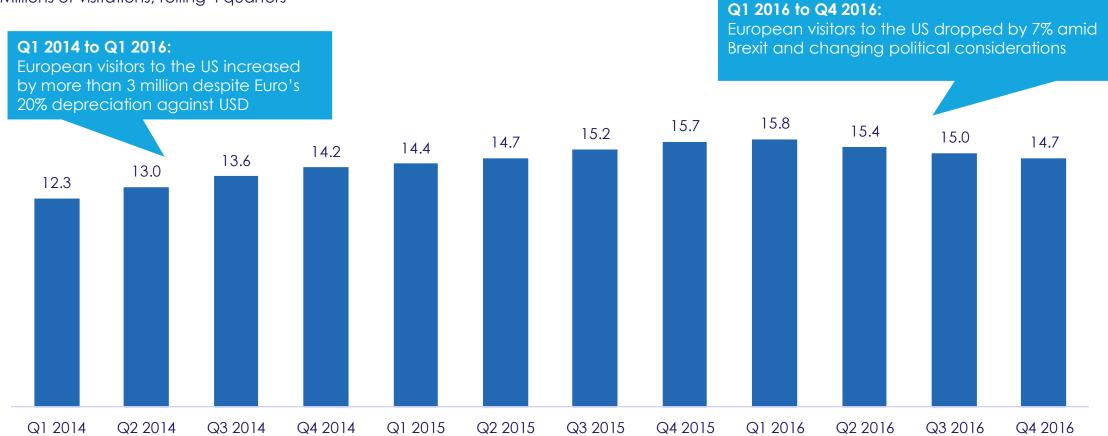

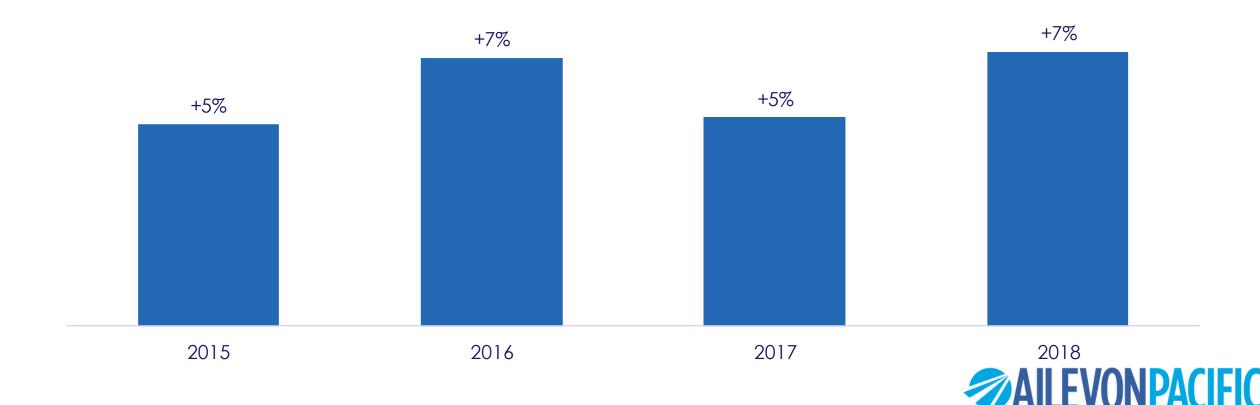

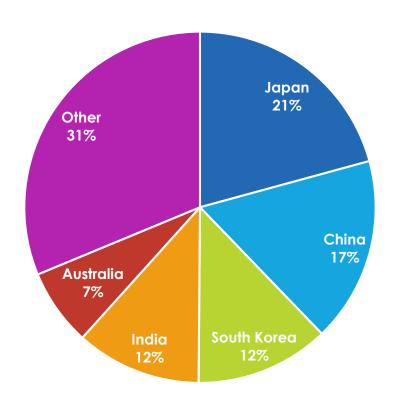

China is set to surpass Japan and become the U.S.' largest O&D market in the Asia Pacific region in the coming years

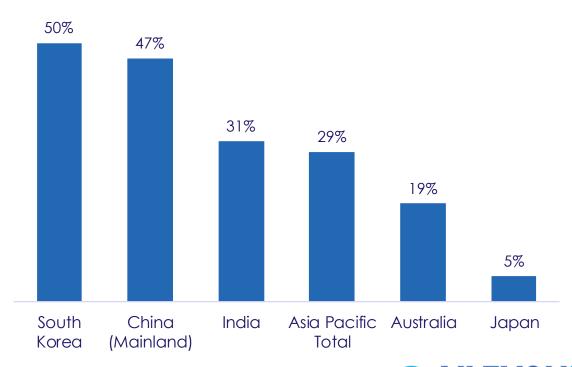
U.S.-ASIA PACIFIC O&D MARKET SHARE BY COUNTRY, YE FEB 2018

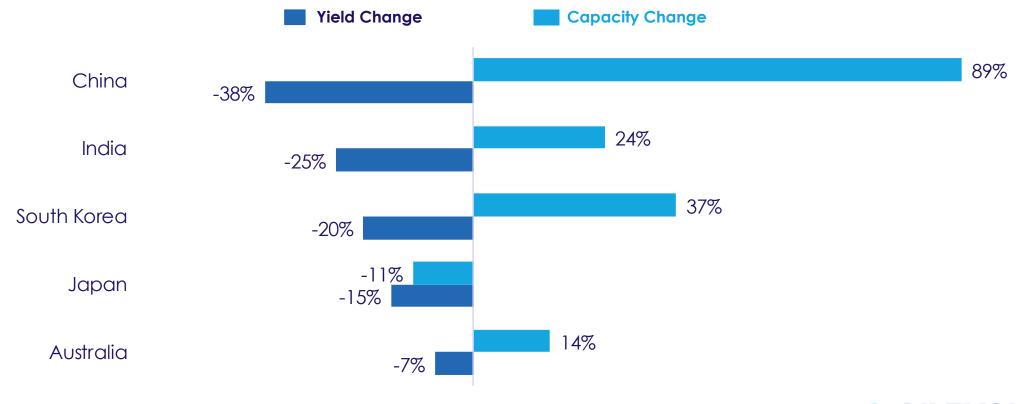




While China experiences rapid growth, its yield deterioration is also the fastest among major Asia Pacific countries

Percent change in yields (USD per revenue passenger mile) vs. percent change in seat capacity





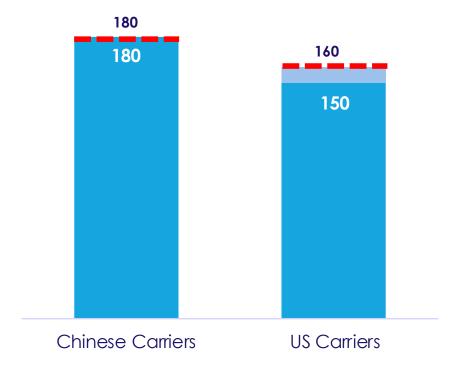

WEEKLY FLIGHTS FROM THE U.S. TO PEK, PVG, CAN, AUGUST 2018

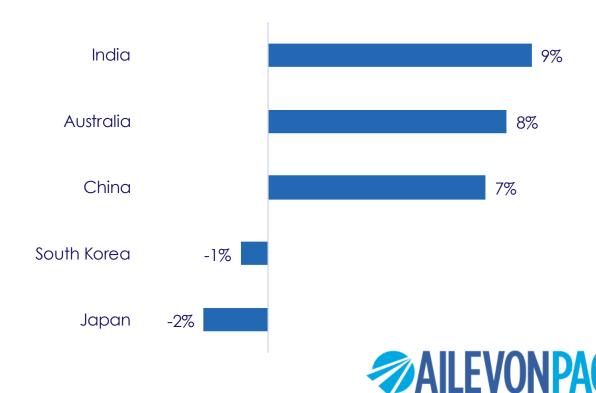
Number of return flights

NORTH AMERICA-ASIA PACIFIC SEAT CAPACITY GROWTH RATE, 2018 VS 2017

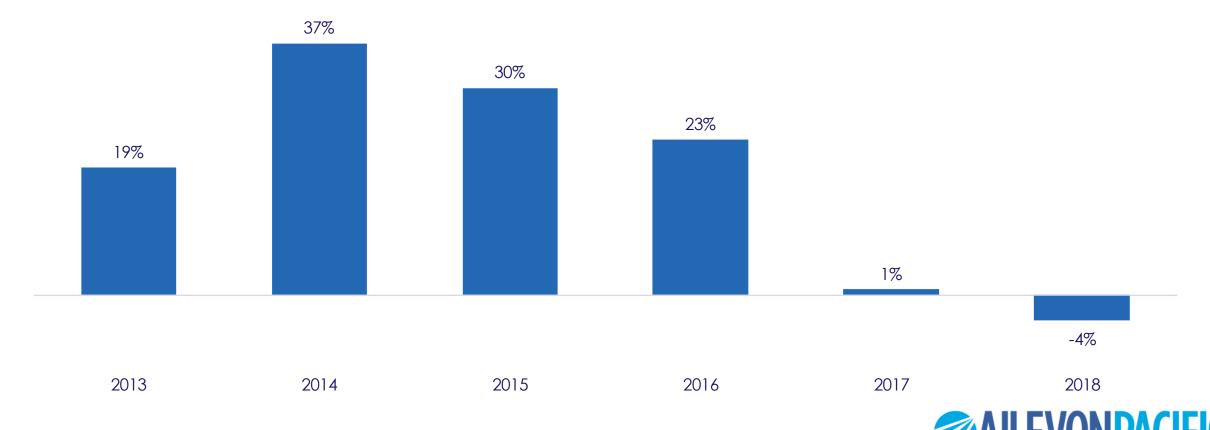
