

FAA Contract Requirements



- Civil rights obligations must be passed on through contracts, regardless of the project funding source
 - Prime contracts, leases, licenses, etc.
 - Subcontracts
- Required FAA contract provisions
 - https://www.faa.gov/airports/aip/procurement/federal_contract_provisions/
 - Airport sponsors must incorporate the FAA contract provisions into their procurement documents <u>verbatim</u>
- Special case: air carriers and airport agreements for accessible boarding equipment (49 CFR 27.72)
- Verify compliance

FAA Contract Requirements



- DBE Program common issues:
 - Conduct and document required monitoring of DBE, participation including reviewing subcontracting records
 - Proactively monitor and enforce prompt payment requirements (applies to all subcontractors, not just DBEs)
 - Ensure adequate staffing to administer the program

FAA Contract Requirements



- ACDBE Program common issues:
 - Conduct and document required monitoring of ACDBE participation
 - Secure FAA approval of long-term and exclusive lease agreements
 - Review joint venture agreements to ensure they are consistent with the joint venture guidance
 - Ensure adequate staffing to administer the program

It is unlawful for airport operators and their lessees, tenants, concessionaires and contractors to discriminate against any person because of race, color, national origin, sex, creed, or disability in public services and employment opportunities. Allegations of discrimination should be promptly reported to the Airport Manager or:

Complaints


- Complaint procedures
 - Include all covered civil rights bases (race, color, national origin, sex, creed, age, disability)
 - Have clear complaint procedures use complaint forms
 - Notify FAA of <u>Title VI complaints</u> within 15 days of receipt
 - Ensure due process for ADA/Sec. 504 complaints
- Ensure tenants and contractors forward complaints

Limited English Proficiency (LEP)

- Four-Factor Analysis and LEP Plan
- Recipients should apply these four factors to determine the extent of their obligation to provide LEP services:
 - 1. Number/proportion of LEP persons in a recipient's area
 - 2. Frequency of contact with LEP individuals for recipient's services
 - 3. Importance of the service provided by the recipient
 - 4. Resources available to the recipient and costs
- Emergency Planning


Facility Issues Design Standards


- Facility design standards: ADA Standards for Accessible Design (ADAAS)
- ADAAS accessible route and circulation path requirements
 - Continuous path connecting all accessible elements and spaces
 - 36" wide (32" at pinch points), minimal slope, accessible doors
 - 20 percent threshold for alterations to path of travel
 - No Protruding objects: >27" and <80" from floor, and >4" from wall/post
 - Applies to parking facilities
 - Applies to temporary structures / detours
- Restroom requirements
- Service animal relief areas



Facility Issues Design Standards

- Loading Zones
 - 1991 Standard: provide signage
 - 2010 Standard: provide street marking for aisle, every 100 feet





Facility Issues

Concessionaire and Airline Space Issues

- Concessionaire spaces
 - Lowered accessible service counter space: 36 inches high
 - Accessible dining areas: 5 percent rule
- Maintenance Obligation
 - Failure to maintain = failure to comply
 - Maintenance Policies







Reasonable Accommodation / Modification

- These are general assistance obligations, in addition to the more specific facility and service requirements
 - Receive and respond to requests
 - Advance notice
 - Undue burden, direct threat, and fundamental alteration
- Best practice: address foreseeable issues through clear policies




Ground Transportation

- Public Transportation
- Private Transportation Licensees
 - Primarily in the transportation business: taxi's, TNC's, airport shuttle services
 - Not primarily in the transportation business: Hotel, rental car center, and offsite parking shuttles
- Obligations
 - Accessible vehicles or equivalent service, as applicable (see next slide)
 - Route and stop announcements
 - Use of lifts/ramps and securement devices
 - Maintain accessibility features
 - Personnel (including drivers and schedulers) trained to proficiency
