

**KENTON COUNTY AIRPORT BOARD
INVITATION TO BID
VAULT 12 SWITCHGEAR REPLACEMENT & UPGRADES (#19-81)**

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS 424.260, the Kenton County Airport Board (Owner) will receive competitive sealed bids for the **Vault 12 Switchgear Replacement & Upgrades** project at the Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport (Airport) located in Boone County, Kentucky (the "Project"). Bids will be received no later than September 19, 2019 at 2:00 p.m. ET. No bids will be accepted after that time unless extended pursuant to an addendum issued by the Owner.

The purpose of this project is to take the first step in creating redundancy in terms of regulator power between Vault 12 and the West Vault. Vault 12 and the West Vault are the main airfield lighting vaults that support CVG's runways and taxiways. These two vaults are critical pieces of CVG infrastructure in order to maintain airfield operations. The scope for this project involves the upgrade of electrical components, such as switchgears and transformers, in Vault 12 to allow for the appropriate sizing as CVG works towards achieving this redundancy. NOTE: This project does not include any work in the West Vault. Preference for Kentucky resident bidders will be applied in accordance with Kentucky law.
