

Request for Qualifications

The Port of Oakland is soliciting qualifications from firms to provide Consulting Services for Airport Geometry Study and Airport Layout Plan (ALP) Update at Oakland International Airport, (RFQ No. 19-20/01), to be delivered to the Purchasing Department, (Attention: Nickulaus Sioson), Port of Oakland at 530 Water Street Oakland, CA 94607, until 11:00 a.m. on October 4, 2019. This project is Federally Funded.

The Project is anticipated to be financed with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Airport Improvement Program (AIP) funds – all contract provisions applicable to FAA AIP funded projects will apply.

The (**Port of Oakland**), in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. §§ 2000d to 2000d-4) and the Regulations, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full and fair opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

A **Pre-Qualification Optional Meeting** will be held on **September 17, 2019 at 10:00 a.m.** at Oakland International Airport, 1 Airport Drive, Oakland, California 94621, Airport Administrative Offices (Terminal 1), Conference Room: Muir Woods.

The successful Responder will provide two primary deliverables. First, an Airport Geometry Study will provide a comprehensive analysis of the airfield facilities which reviews and provides recommendations to address non-compliance with design standards through analysis of horizontal and vertical geometry, hot spots, and other design characteristics. Second, an update of the Airport Layout Plan (ALP) which was last approved by the FAA in 2015.
