


5 STEPS FOR A BETTER SMS

 - Who to train? How to train? What will they gain?




SRM PROCESS FLOW

AIRSIDE AWARENESS

Operational pressure may cause individuals to overlook basic safety rules while operating in the ramp, please remember the following:

- Always check the planed parking stand before and after arrival
- . Check for FOD and/or obstacles on the stand and its surroundings.
- . DO NOT leave unattended and/or obstructing GSE.
- . Unattended GSE/service equipment within the parking stand area can result in a potential accident/incident with an aircraft.
- Lay the ground for a safe flight | If you see something, say something
