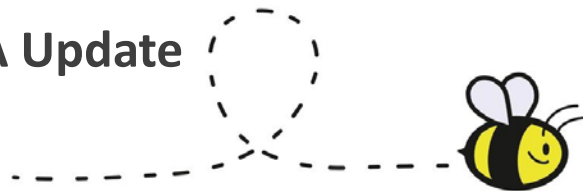

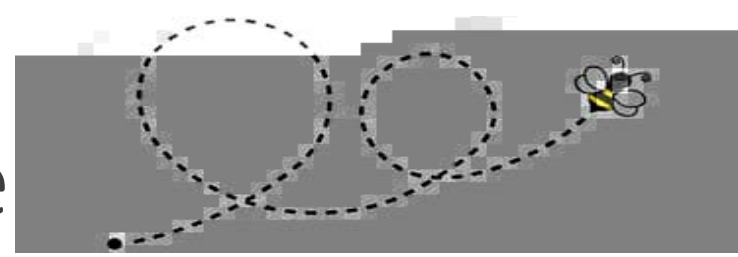


Bird Strike Committee USA

- North American Meeting held August 12-15, 2019 Nova Scotia, Canada
- Key announcements and information:
 - FAA launched a new/updated version of the Wildlife Strike Database website
 - Serial Report #25 was published – Strike data for 1990-2018
 - One of the main trends throughout the conference was a focus on high risk species and how airport managers and researchers should be prioritizing their efforts to address large flocking birds such as geese and cranes, large solitary birds such as raptors, and medium sized flocking birds such as waterfowl.
