JAL's History



Established under the Japan Airlines Act (Act No. 154). 1953 Obtained a license as the sole international scheduled air transportation company. Commenced the first scheduled international 1954 service, with launching of Tokyo - Honolulu -San Francisco route. World's number one passenger and cargo transportation performance according to 1983 IATA. (Maintains No.1 in the world for 5 years, until 1987) 1987 Became full privatization. Japan Airlines and Japan Air System changed trading names to Japan Airlines International and Japan Airlines Domestic. 2004 Changed trading name from Japan Airlines International to Japan 2011 Airlines.

















Cabin Layout & Seat Product in 777-300ER









Haneda & Narita Network Expansion in 2020


