The stress of the pandemic has taken a high toll on many staff members, and HR staff have been taxed in a very particular way. The tasks they were burdened with during this period are those that nobody else in the company had, such as being the bearer of bad news with pandemic-related layoffs, coordinating the move from being in an office environment to working from home online, creating ad hoc guidelines to maintain productivity in an untested work scenario, tasked with having to stay up-to-date with continually shifting employee vaccination mandates and safety requirements as well as enforcing these guidelines, and being the emotional support for other staff. The stress of having to perform so many tasks for which they were not trained for has led to a sweeping burn out across HR departments. Learn what companies can do to support, empower, and retain their HR staff.
