#### 14:30 Airport Dragon's Den-Style Pitch: "Where is my bag?"

The Plug and Play Accelerator team will curate a group of three start-ups who will pitch solutions on how airports can help innovate baggage tracking to improve the passenger experience.

**Problem Statement -** Many components of air travel have been made easier and faster by innovation. We have electronic boarding passes, virtual queuing, advanced declaration and bio-metrics, but the one piece of the passenger journey has been slower to progress is baggage tracking. Aviation stakeholders have incrementally improved baggage check in, tagging and tracking over the years, but what is that next step that will enable industry to adopt digital tags and data visibility for all partners in the ecosystem? Passengers want real-time information on where their bags are. How can we solve this problem together?

Our Airport CEO Dragon's Panel of **RJ Steenstra**, **Myron Keehn** and **Johanne Gallant** will question the start-ups on the relevancy, assumptions, traction and use cases and engage participants.
