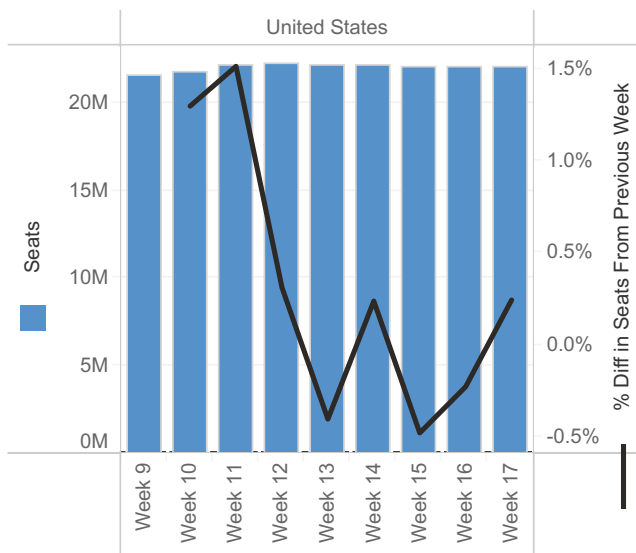

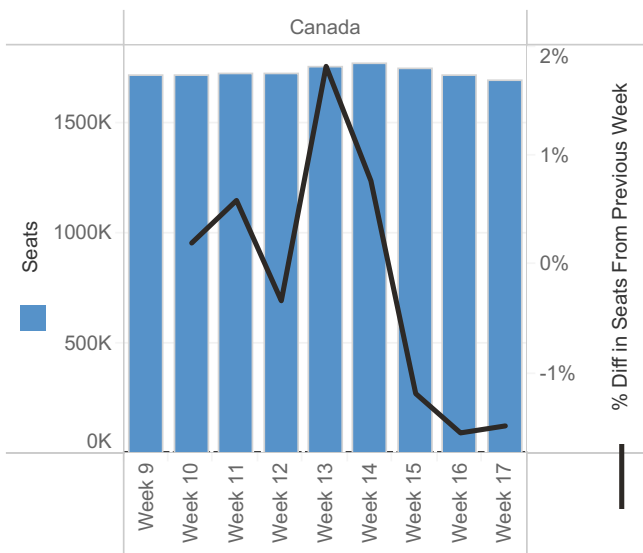

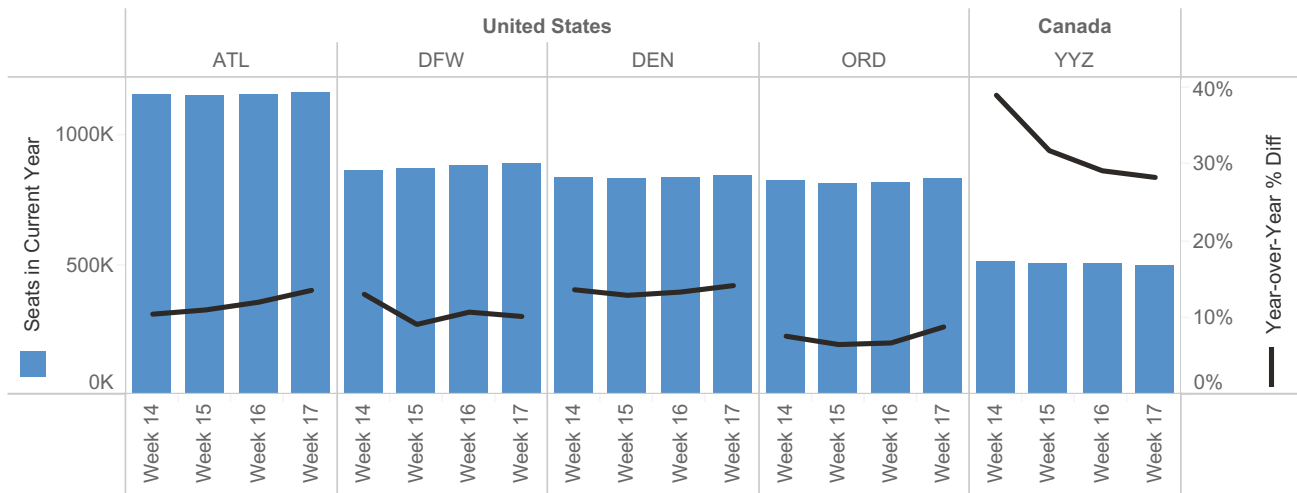
Seats by Week for Previous Two Months (United States)

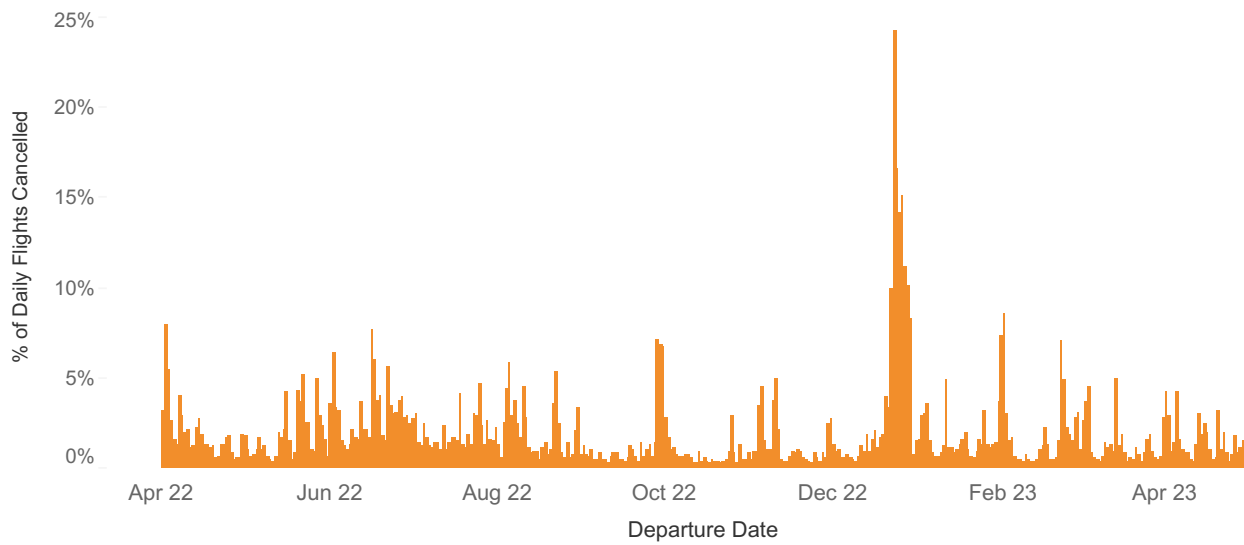

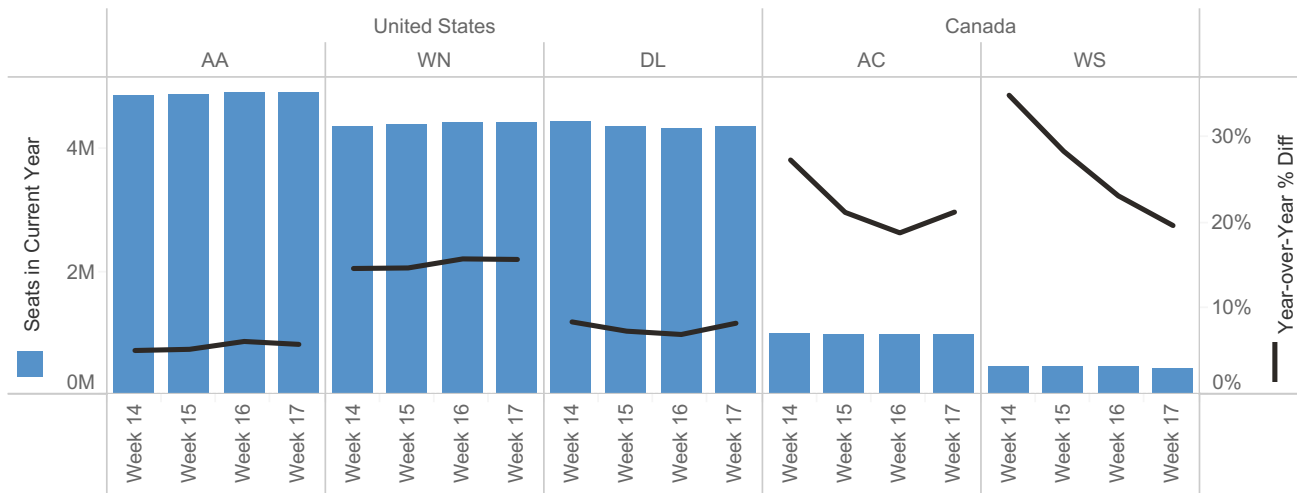

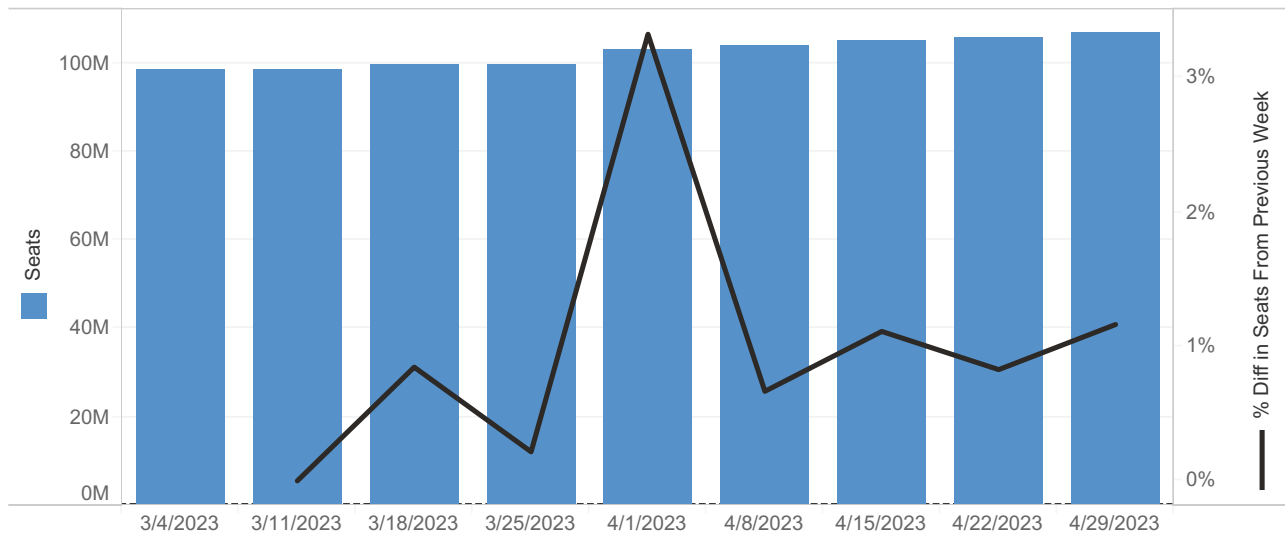

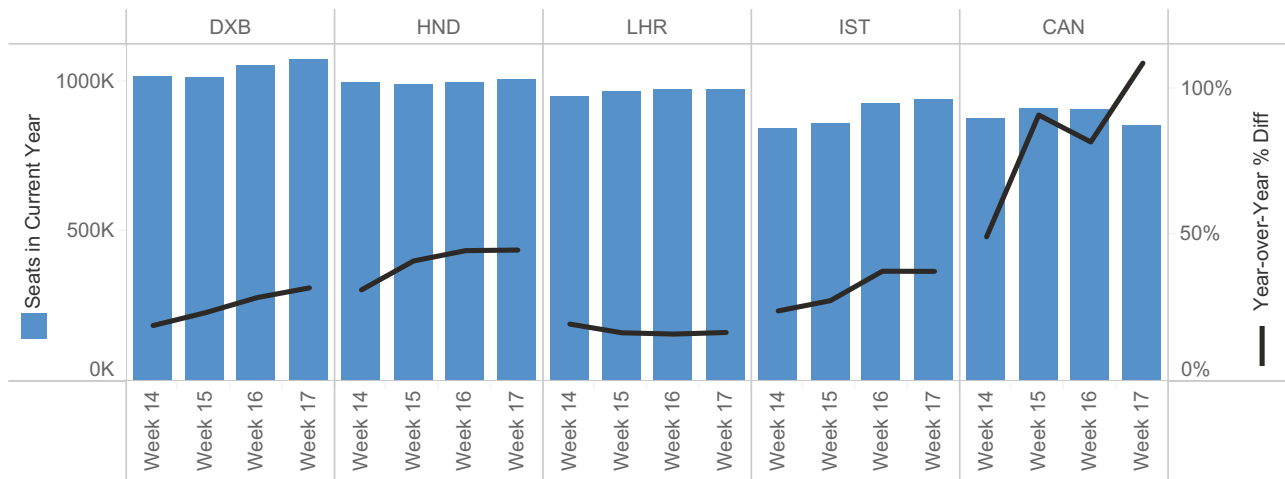

Top 5 non-U.S. and Canada Airports by Seat Volume by Week Compared to Same Week Last Year



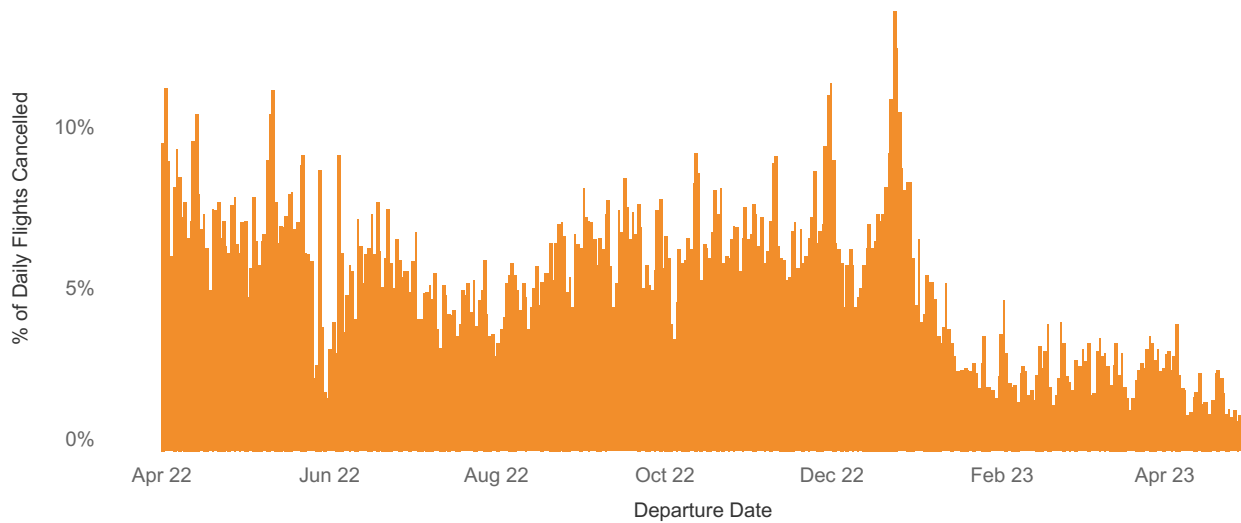

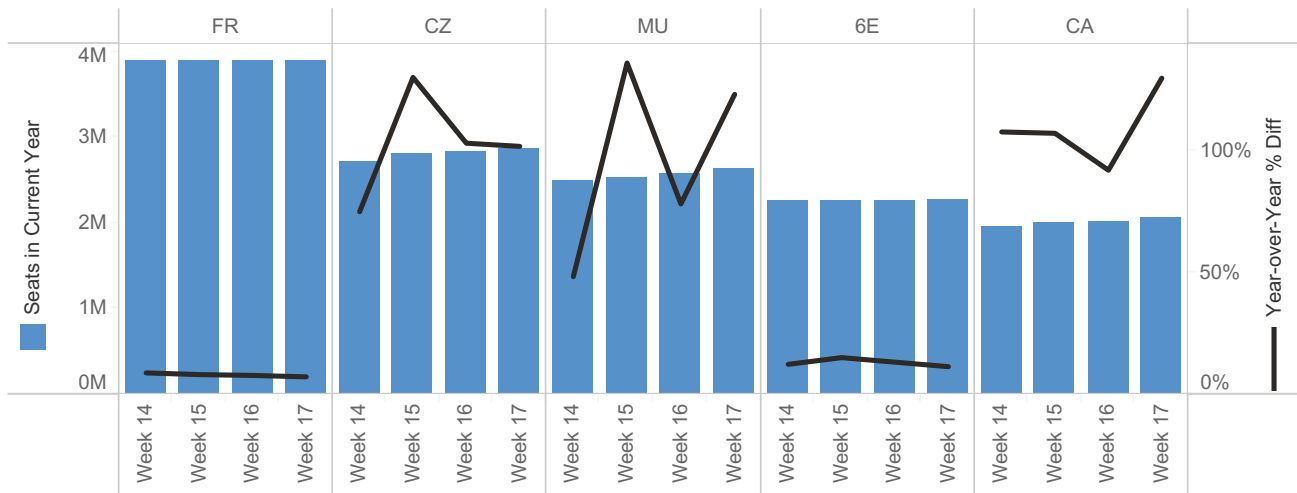

Compares 2023 to 2022 for transcontinental flights longer than 3,000 km

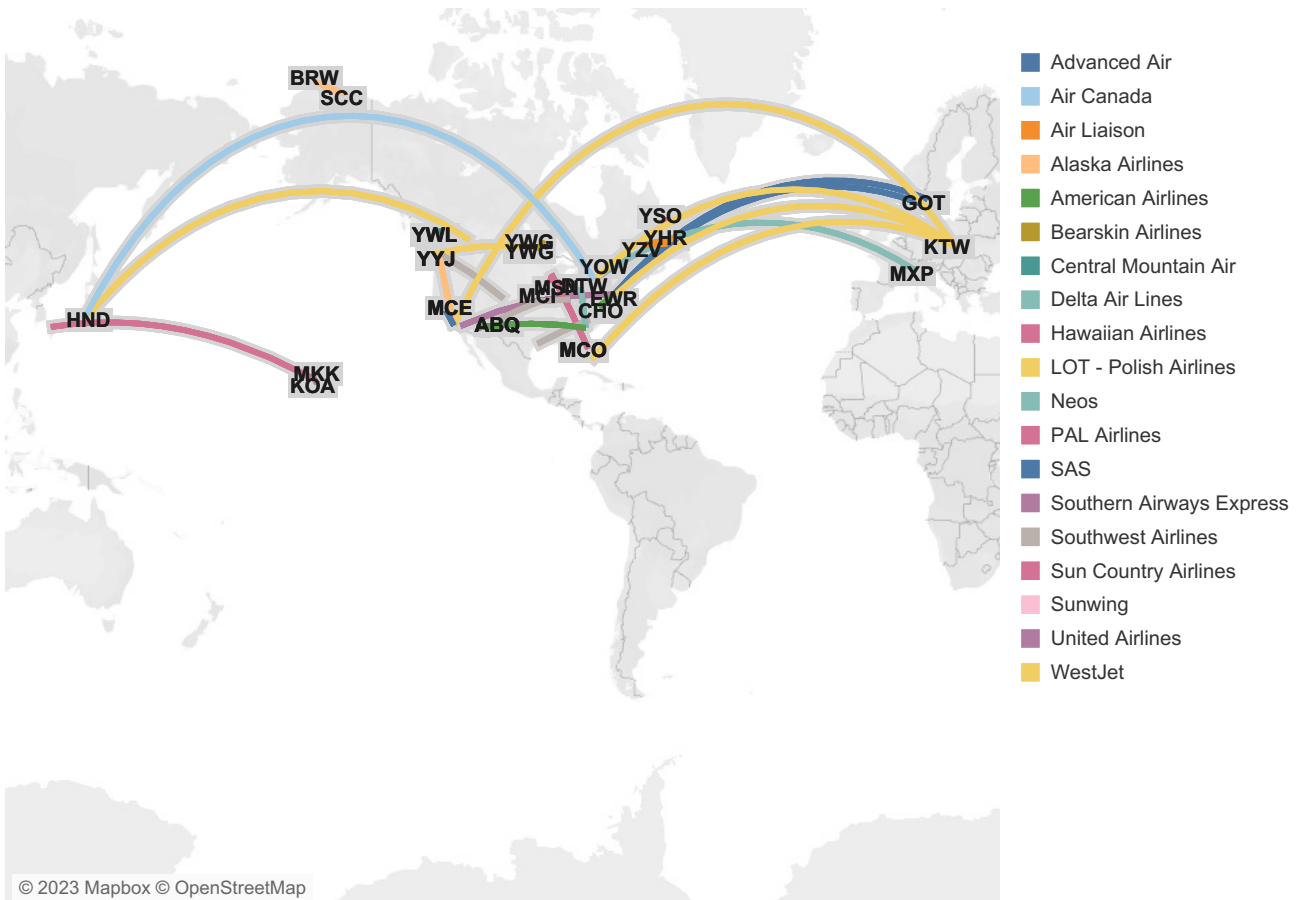

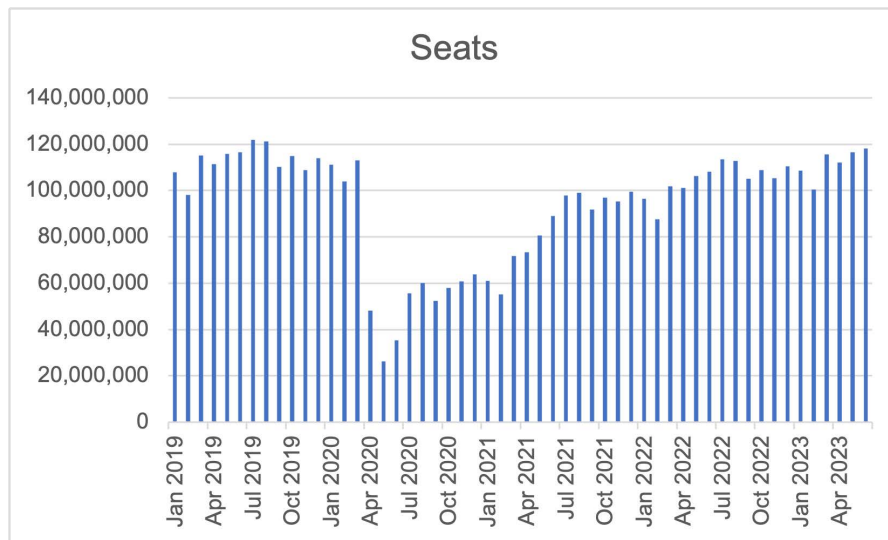

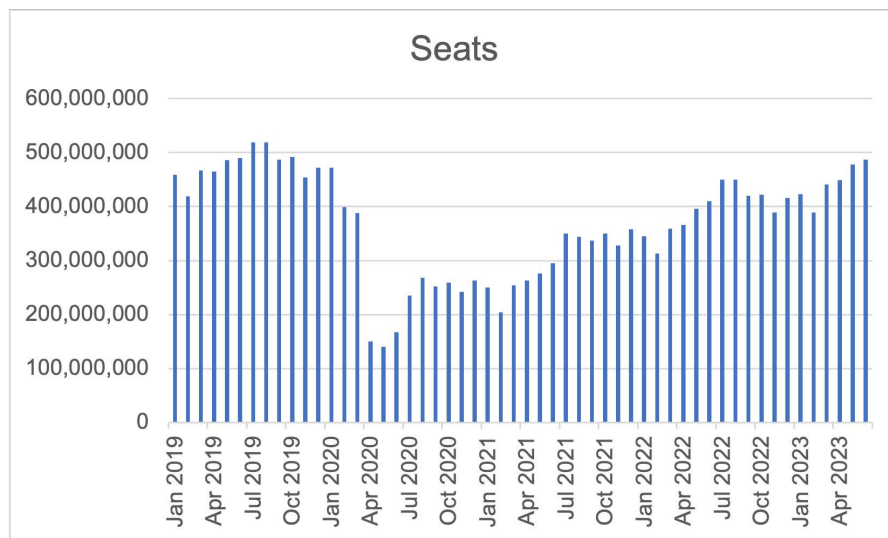
