Pursuant to the U.S. Department of Transportation's Interim Final Rule (IFR) issued September 30, 2025, (see Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program and Disadvantaged Business Enterprise in Airport Concessions Program Implementation Modifications, 90 Fed. Reg. No. 190, page 47969-47982), until TAA completes the reevaluation process described in the IFR, TAA will no longer include ACDBE contract goals or count ACDBE participation toward overall program goals.

At the completion of any contract, the successful proposer will be required to complete and submit a final certification of payments to subcontractor firms on a form to be provided by TAA.
