From Low Cost to High Value: The Evolution of the LCC Model

The traditional definition of a low-cost carrier is rapidly evolving. Many airlines that once competed purely on price are now expanding into premium seating, loyalty programs, and enhanced onboard experiences. As LCCs mature, their strategies increasingly blend elements of both low-cost efficiency and premium revenue generation.

This session will explore how and why the LCC model is changing. Speaker(s) will discuss the rise of hybrid airline strategies, the role of premium seating and ancillary revenue, and how these shifts influence route planning and airport partnerships.

The Future Fleet: How New Aircraft Are Reshaping Airline Networks

Aircraft technology continues to play a defining role in how airlines design their networks and evaluate new routes. Advances in fuel efficiency, range, and aircraft size are enabling airlines to connect markets that were previously unviable, while also reshaping capacity decisions across short-, medium-, and long-haul travel.

Keynote Afternoon Address: International Trends, Regional Consequences & Understanding the Global Drivers of Air Travel

International travel patterns are shifting rapidly, driven by economic cycles, currency fluctuations, geopolitics, and evolving consumer demand. These global forces are increasingly shaping how different regions perform in the international aviation market—from surging outbound demand in some countries to slowing travel in others.

The keynote will explore how global travel trends are influencing regional air service across key markets such as Europe, Asia-Pacific, Latin America, and Canada. How airlines adjust international capacity, how economic and geopolitical developments affect travel flows, and what these shifts mean for airports competing for international service will also be explored. The session will also highlight insights into how global demand patterns translate into regional

opportunities—and how airports can position themselves to capture emerging international travel trends.
